#### DESCRIPTION



**SuperTruth:** Jesus loves me no matter what I've done.

Superverse: Romans 8:39

#### Scripture Read (Optional)

Families get an ESV Bible and have kids find the following passages (Matthew 26:31-35, 56-74; John 21:1-19) in the Bible using the concordance and placing a sticky note by each reference. Once the scripture references are all found, have each member of the family read the story (If kiddo can't read the story have an adult read).

\*During DB kids services we have kids read the Bible because we desire to have them know what scripture says first before engaging in our Superbook Adventure. Remember the Superbook is someone's interpretation of Scripture, and can spur discussion\*

#### **Introduction**

Hello, everyone! Today we will watch a new Superbook adventure called "Peter's Denial." Our video begins with Jesus, Peter, and the other disciples at the Last Supper. This was the last meal Jesus ate before He died on the cross. Listen closely to what Peter and Jesus say and then also what Peter does during the lesson.

#### **Review SuperTruth**

Our SuperTruth for today says, "Jesus loves me no matter what I've done." Say the first part, "Jesus loves me"... and then have the child say the second part "no matter what I've done"

Great job, now let's dive into today's Superbook video and see what Chris, Joy, and Gizmo are up to today.

#### Family Discussion

Now, listen to this: Jesus knows all about us—including every one of our weaknesses—yet He still loves us and wants to be with us!

#### Ask the group:

- Joy was very hurt when Chris denied knowing her. Why did he pretend not to know her, when they are such good friends? *He was afraid of what the basketball players would think.*
- Has a friend ever denied knowing you or turned his/her back on you?
- How did it make you feel?
- Do you think this is the end of Chris and Joy's friendship?

Let's finish our video and see what happens!

#### **Final Family Discussion**

Ask the group:

- Why do you think Peter and the other disciples were afraid to say they knew Jesus?
- Why do you think some people today may be afraid to say they are followers of Jesus?

Peter denied knowing Jesus, but God still loved him no matter what action he did. That doesn't mean He's happy or approved of what Peter did, but he always loved him and forgave him.

God's love is not based on anything we do or don't do. It is based on His nature, because God is love! We cannot earn His love, nor can we do something so bad that we lose it. Romans 5:8 tells us that God showed how much He loved us by having Christ die for us, even though we are sinful! He didn't wait for us to clean ourselves up enough to earn His love; He knows we can never do that.

Our SuperTruth for today is: "**Jesus loves me no matter what I've done**." How does it make you feel to know that?

We do not need to worry about losing Jesus' love—ever!

#### **SUPERVERSE - Practice Throughout the Week**

Our SuperVerse today is Romans 8:39:

"No power in the sky above or in the earth below—indeed, nothing in all creation will ever be able to separate us from the love of God that is revealed in Christ Jesus our Lord. ."."

Say the verse together as a family. Due it 3x with one time doing it normal, second time real quick and the third time really slow.

• Options to memorize: Practice with white board or make hand motions to words.


#### Prayer & Send Off

#### (5 minutes)



<b>6.</b> Did Peter believe it when Jesus said Peter would deny Him?

No, he followed at a distance.
<b>8.</b> Who was the other disciple near Peter in the courtyard?
John.
