#### **Scripture Read (Optional)**

Families get an ESV Bible and have kids find the following passages (Genesis 25:19–34; 27; 32–33) in the Bible using the concordance and placing a sticky note by each reference. Once the scripture references are all found, have each member of the family read the story (If kiddo can't read the story have an adult read).

\*During DB kids services we have kids read the Bible because we desire to have them know what scripture says first before engaging in our Superbook Adventure. Remember the Superbook is someone's interpretation of Scripture, and can spur discussion\*

#### Introduction

Welcome everyone! Today is the second lesson of our Superbook story, "Joseph and Pharaoh's Dream." Before we begin, I would like all those who are watching to think and share with the people around them something they learned last week or know from the story of Joseph.

Before we begin let's review our Supertruth.

#### Review SuperTruth & Discussion

Today's SuperTruth says, "God's plan for Jesus brought salvation to all." Because we are so blessed with His love and forgiveness, we need to remember to show that same love and forgiveness to others!

Say the first part, "God's plan for Jesus..
and then have the child say the second part "brought salvation to all." (Repeat)

God has a plan not just for some people, but for all people, from the beginning of time until the end of time!

If you saw our video in Lesson 1, you'll remember that Chris thought he had a great plan.

But what happened along the way to the soccer match that caused his plan to fail? His

dad stopped to help another person with car problems.

What did Chris learn from that experience? To trust more in God's plan instead of his own.

Now, for the children who haven't seen our Bible story yet, we are going to watch a short version of the video. If you've already seen it, look for answers to the two following questions?

- 1. Who was the brother who Joseph kept with him to make sure his brothers would return to Egypt the second time?
- 2. Whose grain sack contained Joseph's silver cup?

#### Family Discussion

- Do you think it is hard sometimes to accept that God's plan for our lives is different than our plans?
- How do you think it would feel to be Joseph and see your brothers for the first time after all they did to him?

Now let's watch our Bible Background Video and learn more about what the world was like during Joseph's time. When Gizmo asks a question in the video, wait for him to suggest some answers, then call out the one you think is right!

#### Watch: Signpost Video

The Bible is full of so many truths and it is so cool to see how stories in the Old Testament can have symbolic value to God's redemption plan in the New Testament. Let's watch our Signposts Video to see how God's plan for Joseph pointed to God's plan for Jesus—to bring salvation to all.

#### **Teaching:**

Let's say our SuperTruth together: "God's plan for Jesus brought salvation to all."

God has a redemptive plan to save humanity. That has been His desire ever since Adam and Eve sinned in the Garden of Eden. The Signposts Video showed us how God's plan for Joseph's life pointed to God's plan of salvation through Jesus. Picture with me 5 coins, like the

one Joseph put in his brothers sacks, and each coin represents a signpost of how the story of Joseph pointed to God's redemptive plan.

- Coin/Signpost 1: This coin stands for our first signpost. God had a plan for both Joseph and Jesus—to save others. God's plans for Joseph and Jesus were misunderstood by those around them.
- Coin/Signpost 2: This coin stands for our second signpost. Both Joseph and Jesus were dearly loved by their fathers.
- Coin/Signpost 3: This coin stands for our third signpost. Both Joseph and Jesus were betrayed, falsely accused, and arrested. Both Jesus and Joseph forgave those who betrayed them and treated them unjustly.
- Coin/Signpost 4: This coin stands for our fourth signpost. Joseph and Jesus both humbled themselves and became servants.
- Coin/Signpost 5: This coin stands for our fifth signpost. Joseph and Jesus trusted God
  and submitted to God's plan until it was completed. Both were left to die. Joseph was
  rescued from the pit. Jesus died on the cross and was raised from the dead by God.

Joseph's brothers meant to harm him, but Joseph came to understand that all the events in his life were for God's purpose to save others.

Jesus died on the cross to pay the price for our sins, then rose again so we can serve Him here on Earth and live forever with Him in heaven!

Conclusion: Now that is Good News for everyone! Let's say our SuperTruth together: "God's plan for Jesus brought salvation to all."

#### **SUPERVERSE - Practice Throughout the Week**

Our SuperVerse again for the second week is Ephesians 4:32

"Be kind to each other, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, just as God through Christ has forgiven you.."

Say the verse together as a family. Due it 3x with one time doing it normal, second time real quick and the third time really slow.

• Options to memorize: Practice with white board or make hand motions to words.

#### **Prayer & Send Off**


#### (5 minutes)

Ask for several praises & prayer requests. Explain that a <u>praise</u> is something we are thankful God has done and want to give him glory for, and a <u>prayer request</u> is asking God to help with a problem.


STEM ACTIVITY

### WHAT YOU NEED




#### WATER

Enough to fill the plate.



#### PAPER TOWEL

One sheet per person, then keep a roll on hand for cleanup.




#### **PLATE**

Make sure it can hold water.



... or another similar candy.



### DURECTION

#### STEP1

Place a papertowel into the plate and then place Skittles around the edges of the plate.

#### STEP 2

Slowly pour water into the plate. Don't cover the Skittles completely.

#### STEP 3

Watch the plates while the skittles start to mix together to create a cool design.
