WHAT DOES IT MEAN TO GIVE THANKS?

Giving thanks means to showing appreciation to God, or other people, through either our words or actions.

Jesus was passing between the places called Samaria and Galilee when he was met by some interesting people. These people were called lepers and there were ten of them. Lepers had leprosy which was a skin disease. They were not allowed to be around people. They were not liked.

When the ten lepers saw Jesus they stood away from him and shouted, "Jesus, Master, have mercy on us." Many would just walk by and not even look at them, but not Jesus. He replied, "Go and show yourselves to the priests." As they went the ten lepers realized they were healed. They were so excited! One from the group took time to do something important.

One turned back and went back to Jesus and praised Jesus with a loud voice and fell at Jesus' feet and gave Him thanks. Then Jesus said, "Rise and go your way; your faith has made you well."

Christ Connection: *Sin separates us from God; however, because God made a rescue plan through His son, Jesus. Now, we can and should show gratitude for His work: paying the consequences of our sins and giving us the opportunity to accept a restored relationship with Him. Thank God!*

Christ Connection:


Jesus has done so much for us and like the leper who took time to pause and give thanks to Jesus for what he Has done for us by dying on the cross, we should do the same.


